- Don't deposit a check from someone unknown and wire the funds back.
- Don't believe caller ID.
- Always do your research.

#### Protect yourself online:

- Keep personal information personal – Hackers can use social media profiles to figure out your passwords and answer those security questions in the password reset tools. Also be wary of requests to connect from people you do not know.
- Secure your internet connection – Always protect your home wireless network with a password. Be cautious when connecting to a public Wi-Fi.
- Shop Safely – Before shopping online make sure the website is secure. When you are finished shopping and are at the check out screen verify the web address begins with https, also verify that there is a tiny locked padlock symbol that appears before the web address.
