Wicked Bumpers is a small fabrication business started back in 2014 by Ben Railsback. The business focuses on building superior front end protection for pickups and semi-trucks.

Ben graduated from University of Nebraska Lincoln in 2020 and moved back to Humboldt to run the business.

Wicked Bumpers purchased and began operating in the old welding shop on the west side of the square in June, 2020. It has since expanded from working on truck bumpers to include Bahr Welding in Verdon, and Yoder Welding in Pawnee City to create custom cut CNC signs, auxiliary fuel tanks, and skid steer buckets among other custom fabrication jobs.

When John retired in 2016, he was looking for a worthwhile project for himself. The building at 609 G street was available for purchase through the Pawnee City Economic Development Corporation. Because the laundromat had not been rebuilt after the fire, John thought that would be a perfect endeavor.

John and Cindy DeFreece formed the LIJAHU Corporation utilizing the first two letters of their grandchildren's names (Lillian, Jaclyn and Hunter) for this purpose. They reconstructed the space and opened the Missing Sock Laundromat in June of 2017. The space above is basically an apartment and paint studio.

Three years later the building next door at 609 G Street was acquired. The front of the main floor is occupied by River Valley Memorials of Auburn for a satellite office. They are in the Pawnee City office Tuesday through Thursday and by appointment. The back half is used by Creative Thoughts for storage and for a place to work on their beautiful furniture projects.

John is currently in the process of constructing a two-bedroom/two-bathroom apartment in the upstairs area. It should be finished sometime in the spring of 2021.

The Missing Sock stays busy. We are so pleased with how much it is utilized. We are excited to have a new business in an empty building in the downtown area and space for a current business to grow!
