SENCA Investing in Communities Through Education and Partnerships

Southeast Nebraska Community Action (SENCA) serves residents and communities throughout six counties offering a variety of programs and services aimed at the reduction of poverty, the revitalization of low-income communities, and the empowerment of low-income families to become financially independent. SENCA, is a private non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation, incorporated on May 2, 1966 by Evelyn Cooper of Humboldt and Cecil Davis of Pawnee City.



Family Outreach offices are staffed with trained Family Development Specialists who provide services such as: School Back Pack programs, No cost Income Tax Preparation, Emergency Assistance which includes aid for house-holds in danger of being evicted or possibly having their utilities shut off, Food Pantries, and community based services such as Holiday Giving. Both Richardson and Pawnee County offices provide congregate meal sites and offer a Meals on Wheels program. SENCA SMART SAVE Financial Literacy program is being offered to participating schools throughout all six counties during the 2012/2013 school year for 8th and 12th grade students. It focuses on Budgeting, Credit, and Saving. Invest in Yourself, a pro-active adult program, provides job skill training and financial literacy education.

Community Economic Development encompasses a variety of programs providing assistance to qualifying families. Housing Development programs include: Homebuyer Education, SENCA HOMES (down-payment assistance), and Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation. Affordable Housing consists of Multi-family rental housing and elderly/disabled rental housing.

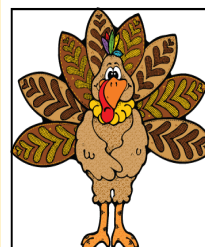

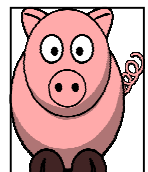

Transit is a low cost public transportation service available to all residents in Richardson and Pawnee Counties Monday through Friday. Rides are by advance appointments only.



Youth Education

SENCA **Head Start** is a comprehensive developmental program for low-income preschool children ages 3 to 5 and their families. Head Start offers a range of diverse services for a total of 156 children and their families in Richardson, Nemaha, Pawnee, and Otoe Counties. Services include but are not limited to: Health and Nutrition, Education, Parent Involvement, and Social Services. The SENCA **Youth Mentoring** program pairs up middle and high school students with a Head Start child and is mutually beneficial because older students gain a sense of usefulness, importance and responsibility while Head Start students gain a friend and a role model. SENCA actively plays a part in each of the communities served and works with a variety of businesses, community groups and faith based organizations to sponsor events such as: The Jingle Bell Ride in Falls City, Nemaha County Gives Back in Auburn, The Back to School Bash in Plattsmouth, School Back Pack Programs, and numerous Food Drives. The SENCA Annual Golf Tournament held at Kirkman's Lakeview Golf Course celebrated its 7th tournament in June and grossed close to \$8,000 that will benefit youth programs.

The SENCA central office is located in Humboldt and is home for the Administrative staff, Fiscal Department, Head Start Coordinators, and the Weatherization Department. The SENCA Board of Directors, nine volunteers from the six county service area, Executive Director, Vicky McNealy along with a staff of 75 employees, are dedicated to the mission of: "Investing in our neighbors through education and partnerships to improve lives and build strong communities in southeast Nebraska."
